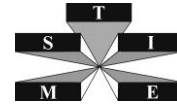
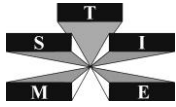

He is the Director of Forbes Calamity Prevention Pte Ltd, and past president of the Asia Council of the International Association of Emergency Managers (IAEM). He holds MBCI and CBCP professional credentials in business continuity. He also recruits and places EM, CM and BCM professionals in Asia through Staff on Standby www.staffonstandby.com.

He talked his way across the border from India into Nepal in 1973 with no passport, no visa and no identification of any kind in 1973. He led 700 taxi drivers in a 56-day strike in the winter of 1975-76 in Minnesota. He started the first nationwide electronic tax filing service for independent tax preparers in the United States in 1984, and sold it to the software company Intuit in 1992.

He is a cancer survivor. In 1993 he was diagnosed with malignant melanoma and told he had a 20% chance of survival. 20 years later he doesn't have cancer, but does have a keen interest in the ways organizations manage disease and employee health. He bungie-jumped off a bridge in New Zealand in 2003 for his 51st birthday.
