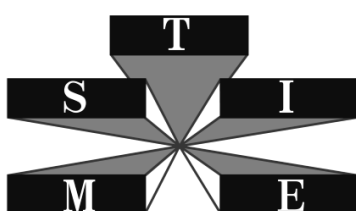

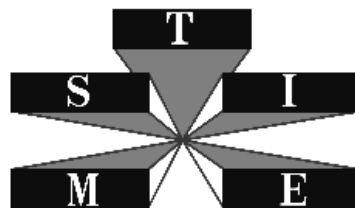

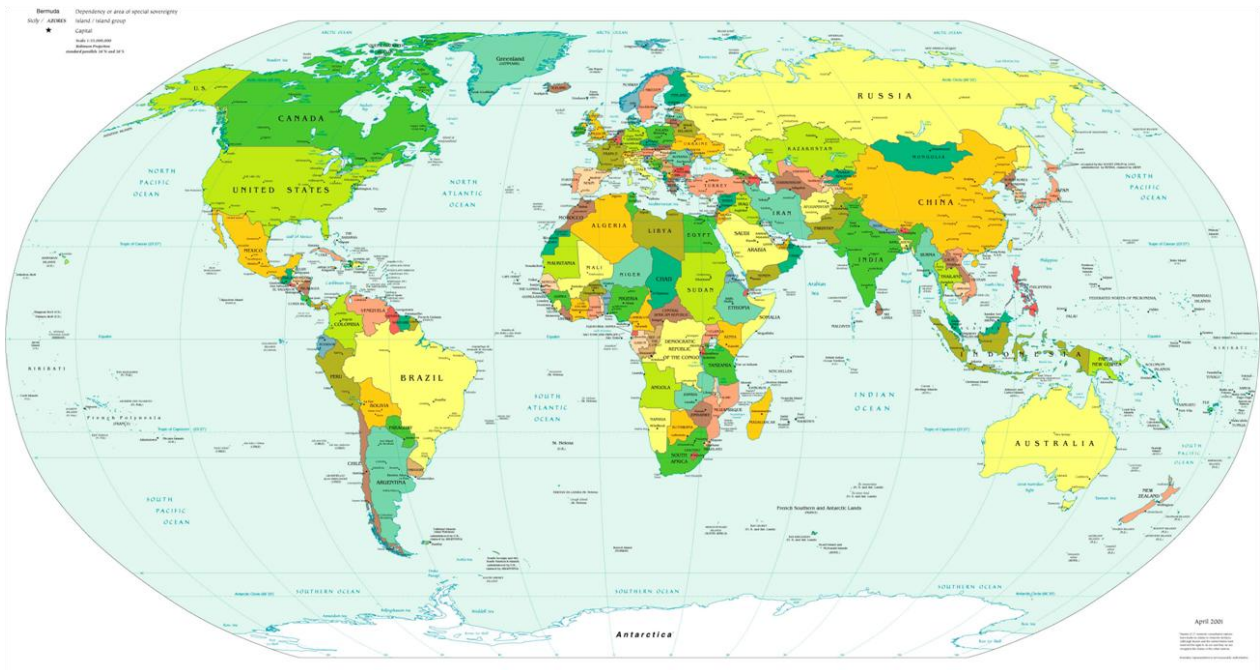

Its objective was to design, validate and promote responsive systems/solutions for effective resilience of Culture Heritage sites against climate change effects.</p> <p>TIEMS was responsible for operational procedures for disaster prevention and risk management, best practise manual, and guidelines for virtual training courses.</p> <p>Read More</p>	 <p>Action Plan on Science in Society Related issues in Epidemics and Total Pandemics</p> <p>The ASSET project, a Seventh Framework Program project funded by the European Commission, was finalized in 2017. Its objective was to forge a partnership with complementary perspectives, knowledge and experiences to address effectively scientific and societal challenges raised by pandemics and associated crisis management.</p> <p>TIEMS was responsible for establishing a High Level Policy Forum and Collection and analysis of experiences of participatory governance in crisis management and an Action Plan Definition in pandemics and epidemics.</p> <p>Read More</p>	 <p>Public Safety Communications Europe Forum - PSCE</p> <p>PSCE, was established as a result of the European Commission funded project, NARTUS, which was finalized in 2009. Since then, PSCE has evolved into an independent forum, where representatives of public safety user organisations, industry and research institutes can meet to discuss and exchange ideas and best practices, develop roadmaps and improve the future of public safety communications.</p> <p>TIEMS responsibility in the EU project NARTUS was consensus building and establishing PSCE</p> <p>Read More</p>	 <p>Network of European Hubs for Civil Protection and Crisis Management</p> <p>TIEMS was a subcontractor to Ecory's Company, in the Netherlands, for developing an expert HUB on wildfire expertise in Europe for the European Commission DG ECHO project "Network of European Hubs for Civil Protection and Crisis Management". This HUB should serve as a prototype/example for establishing other HUBs with special expertise on other disaster types. The final report was published in 2020.</p> <p>Read More</p>
